

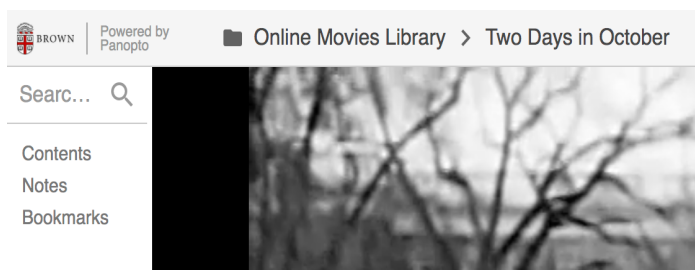
## Adding Notes in Panopto (for class discussion)

1. Go to the Media Library in Canvas and begin playing the movie the class is discussing.



2. Click on "Notes" in the left sidebar menu.



3. Next, click on "Join a channel..."

*Make sure you type in the class channel name correctly, or else no one will be able to see your notes. Ask your instructor to confirm the name if they are asking you to follow this process.*
