

Cognos Analytics authors can add images to reports and prompt pages like Brown logos, custom images, and <u>bootstrap icons</u>.


**NOTE**: Contact us if you need a logo or other image added to Cognos Analytics to use in reports.

Add an Image to Your Report

- 1. In the report authoring tool, navigate to the report page where you want to add an image.
- From the **Toolbox** pane, expand **LAYOUT**, and then drag an **Image** object to your report page.



3. Double click the image object, and then click **Browse**. *An image directory appears*.



- The system adds the image to your report.
- To adjust the image size, select the image and then from the Show
  properties pane, use the Size & overflow property to adjust the image size.
  NOTE: Brown logos default to the sizes available in the Brown Image Gallery, which is typically quite large.
