The Certificate of Data Destruction is a formal attestation used to confirm that sensitive data has been fully and securely destroyed in accordance with Brown University requirements. Commonly used within secure environments like Stronghold, this certificate documents the removal of data from all individuals and systems involved. Completion of this form helps ensure compliance with contractual, regulatory, and institutional standards for data handling and disposal. Individual research groups are responsible for submitting the form, which is maintained by the Information Security Group.
