## Embed TimelineJS into BrownBlogs (Wordpress)

The TimelineJS plugin allows users to embed a dynamic timeline created using the [Knight Lab TimelineJS](#) tool into the BrownBlogs platform.

Start with a Google Spreadsheet that follows the [TimelineJS Template](#).

Once a timeline has been created, follow these instructions to embed it into BrownBlogs.

1. Log in to [blogs.brown.edu](https://blogs.brown.edu) as an author or editor.
2. Enable the "Knight Lab TimelineJS" plugin from the **Plugins** menu in the blog's Dashboard.
3. **Add a new blog post**
4. Click on the "**Add Timeline**" button
5. Paste the URL of an existing Google Spreadsheet that uses the TimelineJS template into the "**Data source**" field.
6. Click "**Insert Timeline**" and **Publish** the blog post.
