Embed TimelineJS into BrownBlogs (Wordpress)

The TimelineJS plugin allows users to embed a dynamic timeline created using the <u>Knight</u> <u>Lab TimelineJS</u> tool into the BrownBlogs platform.

Start with a Google Spreadsheet that follows the <u>TimelineJS Template</u>.

Once a timeline has been created, follow these instructions to embed it into BrownBlogs.

- 1. Log in to <u>blogs.brown.edu</u> as an author or editor.
- 2. Enable the "Knight Lab TimelineJS" plugin from the **Plugins** menu in the blog's Dashboard.
- 3. Add a new blog post
- 4. Click on the "Add Timeline" button
- 5. Paste the URL of an existing Google Spreadsheet that uses the TimelineJS template into the "**Data source**" field.
- 6. Click "Insert Timeline" and Publish the blog post.
