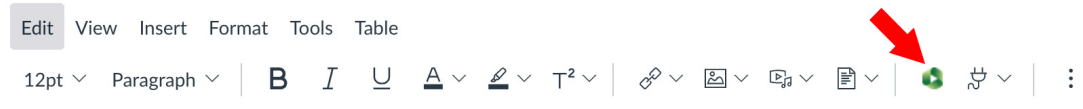


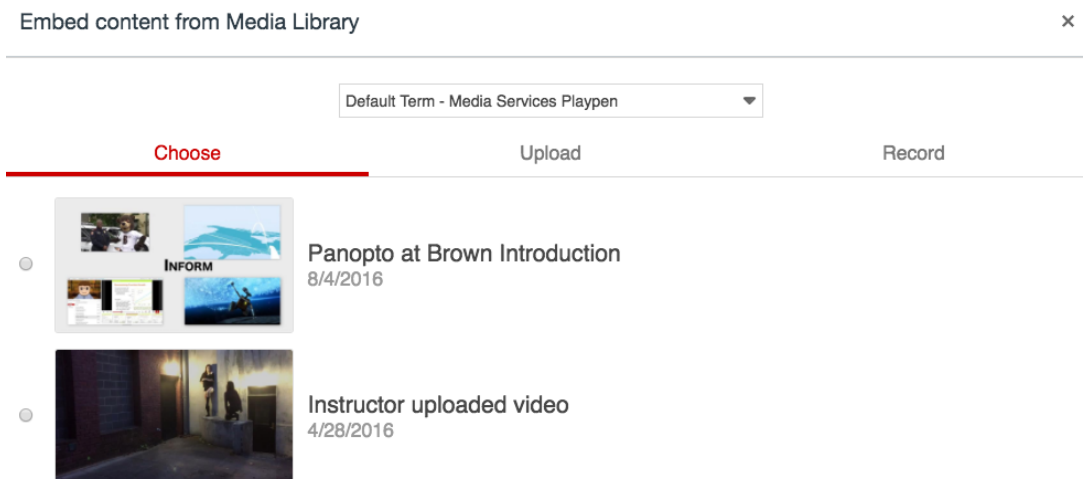
Embedding Panopto videos in a Canvas page

When embedding a video from the Panopto Media Library onto a Canvas page you must click the **Media Library** button in the Canvas page editor.




The video selection window will open and default to the content of the folder for the course you are currently in.



If you prefer to embed a video from a different folder you must change the folder in the drop down menu.

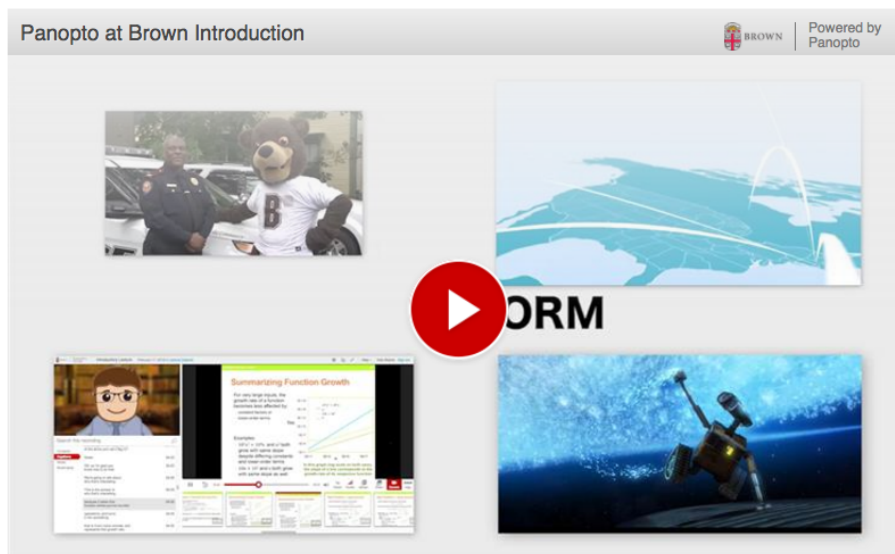
