Access may be requested through the [application request form](#); choose Google Cloud Platform (GCP) in the Applications section.

Who can access GCP?

Students may request access to GCP if needed to complete a class project, but this will **require** the class professor to confirm the need for this access. Faculty may request access to GCP for their entire class and provide their class Google Group.
