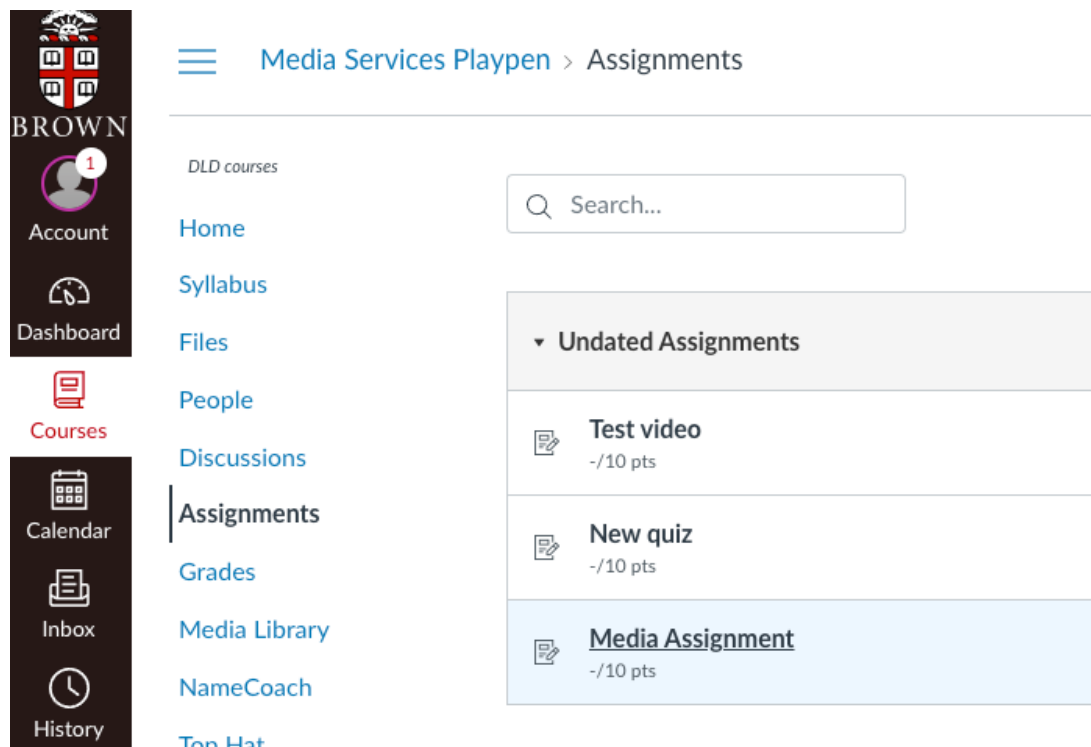

Add your Panopto Recording to a Canvas Assignment

1. Navigate to your course in Canvas and then to the Assignments tab on the left. Select the assignment that you need to submit..




