What is Hypothesis

Hypothesis is a tool that helps students collaboratively annotate online readings.

Students can:

- select text to annotate
- · add tags and post publicly or save privately
- reply to or share any annotation
- link to notes or whole pages
- annotate together in groups
- · collaborate privately with others
- search notes


Getting Started with Hypothesis in Canvas

- 1. In Assignments, choose +Assignment
- 2. Under Submission Type, choose **External Tool** then click **Find** next to the link box.
