Text Instructions

There are two ways to insert a web link when you create any page or post in Canvas:

Option 1: Copy and paste

1. Copy and paste the web link into the Rich Content Editor.
2. Press Enter. The pasted text will turn blue, signifying that it has become a link to the web page.
3. Click **Save**.

Option 2: Select the link icon

1. Click the **Link to URL** icon in the toolbar above the Rich Content Editor.
2. Type or copy and paste the web link in the window that appears.
3. Click **Insert Link**.
4. Click **Save**.

Turn text or images into a link

1. Highlight a word, phrase, or image.
2. Click the **Link to URL** icon in the toolbar above the Rich Content Editor.
3. Type or copy and paste the web link in the window that appears.
4. Click **Insert Link**.
5. Click **Save**.
