Resource	Description
<u>Free training from</u> <u>Tableau</u>	 The makers of Tableau products offer a variety of free training. <u>Tableau Starter Kits</u>—Practice authoring, interacting, publishing, and administering Tableau through a multimedia introduction to Tableau. <u>Watch on demand videos</u> (topics range from a few minutes to 1+ hours) <u>Live online training</u> (or view <u>past training recordings</u>) <u>Attend a webinar</u> (or view <u>past webinar recordings</u>)
LinkedIn Learning	Take advantage of Brown's free LinkedIn Learning site license. Check out training on these topics: • <u>Tableau training</u> • <u>Data visualization training</u>
<u>Rhode Island</u> <u>Tableau User</u> <u>Group</u>	Join the <u>local Tableau user group (TUG) hosted by the Providence</u> <u>Public Library</u> . Meets quarterly.
<u>Udemy</u>	While not free, Udemy offers <u>more affordable Tableau training</u> (sometimes on sale for under \$20!).
	Brown users who took their <u>Master Course in Tableau 10 & 2019</u> for <u>Business Intelligence</u> gave it excellent reviews and described it as good for users who have mastered the basics with free training from Tableau and LinkedIn Learning (see above) and want to take it to the next level. Please note, this particular course teaches an outdatedversion of Tableau Desktop as of this writing.
<u>Weekly Wind Down</u> <u>Webinars</u> (past recordings)	UPDATE : Senturus no longer runs this series, but <u>previous</u> recordings are available. On Friday afternoons, Senturus, offers a free 30-minute webinar with tips, tricks, and tutorials for Tableau Desktop users and/or Cognos Analytics authors (many of our users use both!).

<u>Tableau Public</u> <u>Gallery</u>	The <u>Tableau Public Gallery</u> is great for inspiration. Browse or search visualizations by keyword. See something you like? You can download a visualization and take a peek under the hood to see how it was accomplished. Note : <u>Tableau Public</u> is a free product. Visualizations are published to the Tableau Public Server to be available in the gallery for the world to see and enjoy. Published visualizations can also be embedded on a web page.
<u>Workbook &</u> Calculation Library	Browse and share Tableau Workbooks and calculations.
<u>Data Revelations</u> <u>Blog</u>	Stephen Wexler as an experienced Tableau trainer and author who writes an <u>informative blog</u> including content on <u>visualizing</u> <u>survey data</u> , which can be tricky. Subscribe <u>here</u> .
