Wi-Fi calling can be useful in low reception areas. It's supported on Brown-paid iPhones on AT&T and Verizon and may also work on your personal iPhone as long as you have an iPhone 5c or later <u>on a supported carrier</u>. If your phone and plan support it, here's how to set it up.

On your phone, select **Settings** > **Phone** > **Wi-Fi Calling**.

Enable the Wi-Fi Calling on This iPhone slider.
