You can share Tableau data visualizations in several ways:

- Export view as: [PDF](#) | [Image](#)
- [Tableau Server](#)—Brown staff with a [Tableau Creator license](#) can publish and share visualizations securely with a defined audience to Tableau Server. Published content can also be [embedded](#) on a Brown website.
- [Packaged workbook](#) + [Tableau Reader](#)—A [Tableau Desktop user](#) creates a packaged workbook (a single file that contains both the viz and data). With Tableau Reader, another user can open, view, and interact with the workbook. Tableau Reader is a free download; think of it like Adobe Reader for visualizations.
- [Tableau Public](#)—Publish and share visualizations publicly on the Tableau Public server and optionally [embed on a website](#).
- [Tableau Online](#)—This is a hosted version of Tableau Server available to faculty/instructors with a license through the [Tableau for Teaching program](#).
