Share and Publish Tableau Visualizations

You can share Tableau data visualizations in several ways:

- Export view as: <u>PDF | Image</u>
- <u>Tableau Server</u>—Brown staff with a <u>Tableau Creator license</u> can publish and share visualizations securely with a defined audience to Tableau Server. Published content can also be <u>embedded</u> on a Brown website.
- <u>Packaged workbook</u> + <u>Tableau Reader</u>—A <u>Tableau Desktop user</u> creates a packaged workbook (a single file that contains both the viz and data). With Tableau Reader, another user can open, view, and interact with the workbook. Tableau Reader is a free download; think of it like Adobe Reader for visualizations.
- <u>Tableau Public</u>—Publish and share visualizations publicly on the Tableau Public server and optionally <u>embed on a website</u>.
- <u>Tableau Online</u>—This is a hosted version of Tableau Server available to faculty/instructors with a license through the <u>Tableau for Teaching program</u>.
