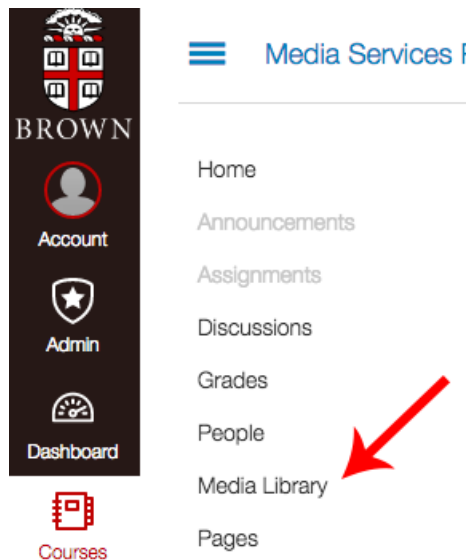


Uploading Video and Audio to Media Library in Canvas

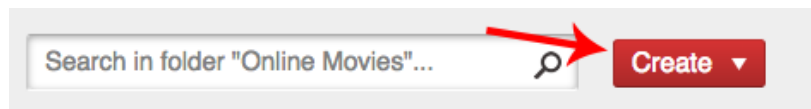

How to upload video or audio to your Canvas course using Panopto

1. Log in to your Canvas course (canvas.brown.edu) and select Media Library from the left navigation.






2. At the top, click the Create button next to the search bar.



There will be a drop down menu that allows you to **Upload media**, **Record a new session** (which requires the Personal Recorder software), or create a **New Folder** in the course. Select **Upload Media**
