Course Recording Storage Options

Method	Location	Retention
Instructors using Canvas	Recordings are stored automatically in your Canvas Media Library	6 Years
Instructors using Panopto only	Recordings are stored automatically in your Panopto folder	6 Years
Instructors not using Canvas or Panopto [*]	Zoom	6 months only

Zoom Meeting Storage Recommendations for non-course recordings

Zoom meetings and event recordings can be stored in your Google Drive to save them for longer than 6 months. Here are the <u>instructions</u>.
